The Russ College of Engineering and the College of Business charge technology fees that have not changed since the FY 2002 budget was approved. The College of Communication will begin charging a technology fee as shown above in the fall of 2002.

Part-time students in the Russ College of Engineering are assessed a pro-rated fee at a rate of \$9 per hour for undergraduates and \$11 per hour for graduates. Part-time students in the College of Business are assessed a pro-rated fee at a rate of \$6 per hour. Part-time students in the College of Communication will be assessed a pro-rated fee at a rate of \$7 per hour for undergraduates and \$9 per hour for graduates.

In addition to the technology fees detailed above, the College of Osteopathic Medicine has established a college-wide learning resource fee to support learning resource services and instructional materials in years 1 and 2, and continuing design, development, and technological assistance for distance learning in years 3 and 4. The fee is \$170 per quarter for returning students and \$179 per quarter for new students. The College of Osteopathic Medicine began charging this fee in the fall of 2001.
